Delays in obtaining URN / Permission for Destruction of Controlled Substances from NCB

Members are aware that As per RCS (NDPS) Order, 2013, any entity intending to deal with a controlled substance such as Acetic Anhydride, Ephedrine or Pseudoephedrine salts, etc., listed in Schedule A, are required to make an application for URN (Unique Registration Number) from NCB in Form B and in case of destruction of the same, make an application in Form I.

It is understood that during a recent meeting with NCB officials at Mumbai, many participants had raised concerns about undue delays in obtaining URN / Permission for destruction of controlled substances. In order to understand the gravity of concerns raised in the meeting, the NCB officials would like to know the number of such pending cases.

Therefore, members who are dealing with controlled substances, are requested to submit data if there are any delays in obtaining URN/Permission for destruction, in the following format, to info@bdmai.or; ed@bdmai.org;
