Sub: Review meeting by PMO – Long Term Measures for developing domestic resilience in Pharma Sector

BDMAI received a communication from the Department of Pharmaceuticals that in the context of unrest in West Asia, a review meeting is scheduled soon by Prime Minister's Office to discuss on the long-term measures for developing domestic resilience in Pharma Sector and requested for inputs / suggestions from the industry on the following:

- 1. Potential vulnerabilities in the pharmaceutical supply chain arising out of the current West Asia situation;**
- 2. Dependence on imports of APIs, intermediates, solvents, excipients, packaging materials, logistics routes, energy inputs, etc.;**
- 3. Measures required for strengthening domestic manufacturing resilience and supply chain diversification;**
- 4. Any policy support/interventions required from Government to mitigate future risks.**

Since it is a right opportunity to put forth the challenges faced by the industry, members are requested to share practical issues, likely challenges, and suggestions based on their experience, so that a comprehensive representation may be submitted to the Government.
