Sub: EPTRI – TGPCB – Inventorisation Study in E-Waste Management in Telangana – request to provide EEE being used and information from Pharmaceutical Companies in Telangana – Reg.

The Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India (GOI) is concerned about the tremendous generation of e-Waste due to increased usage of Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) and notified the e-Waste Management Rules, 2022. In this process, Telangana Pollution Control Board (TGPCB) would like to know the total quantity of e-waste generated in Telangana as per schedule-I of e-Waste Management Rules, 2022, and had awarded the Inventorisation Study in E-Waste Management in Telangana to Environment Protection Training and Research Institute (EPTRI) an autonomous Institute under the aegis of Department of Environment Forest Science & Technology, Government of Telangana, and is one of the premier organisation working on Environment Protection and related activities.
